



RCCongress 2010 Scholarship

Religion Communicators Congress 2010 (RCCongress 2010) brings together more than 1,000 communications professionals to expand their experience and broaden their perspectives on embracing change. This once-a-decade multi-faith forum for all levels of communicators of religion will be held in Chicago, Ill., April 7-10, 2010.

Religion communicators are the purveyors of stories that need to speak in today's world. RCCongress 2010 will ask the question, how do we tell the stories of wonder and longing, resilience and forgiveness, hope and restoration to new audiences? To answer this question communicators will explore ever advancing technology, power shifts in the world of publishing, and new avenues of communication. RCCongress 2010 will ask how do we effectively use the power of communication to effect change in our world?

The scholarship is open to all currently enrolled college/graduate students between the ages of 20-28.

The scholarship to the Congress includes: paid registration for the Congress and paid hotel room (double occupancy) for five nights (\$800 value). Travel expenses and additional meal costs are student's responsibility. *Scholarship recipients are expected to arrive in Chicago on Tuesday, April 6 and are required to be present for the entire event.*

- Challenging plenary speakers on timely issues with global impact
- More than 50 skills-building workshops to teach you cutting edge communication
- Expert roundtable interest groups for information sharing among communications pros, and
- Networking and idea exchange with an interfaith, global gathering of communications professionals.
